The children will be celebrating Valentine's Day with a party that includes a Valentine exchange on **February and 12th and 13th**. Wear your favorite valentine color! When working on valentines, please make sure that you or your child signs his/her name on the card, but **please do not write the names of classmates on the individual cards.** (That makes handing them out very tricky!) Put the cards in a bag and label the bag with your child's name. Each child who brings in cards will have the chance to play mailperson for the morning and deliver his/her cards to classmates. PROGRESS REPORTS AND EVALUATIONS:

Every child is unique and born with a developmental time clock that determines readiness in many areas of growth. During the month of February, we will begin the process of evaluating all children attending our program. From the beginning of school in September, we have been observing the following areas: social development, cognitive skills, play habits, attitudes, language development and motor skills. All staff members will have an input into the evaluation process of each child. You will be given a report in April that outlines the staff observations. We feel fortunate that we see parents/

caregivers on a weekly basis, so we can share day-to-day happenings here at Busy Bees. If we feel that we need to speak to you about a certain issue involving your child, we will do so before progress reports are issued and whenever the need arises throughout the school year. Both classes are involved, interactive and eager to learn. The time and energy that you invest in your children's lives is very evident.

REMINDER ABOUT WELLNESS POLICY:

There are a lot of respiratory illnesses going around the community. **In order to keep our teachers and children healthy please follow these guidelines** and keep your child home if they are not well. **We appreciate your cooperation!**

In order for your child to attend Busy Bees they must:

- Be fever free for 24 hours WITHOUT the use of medications
- Symptoms are getting better and your child can manage through the routine of a typical morning in our care

Symptoms are NOT improving if:

- Fever (100.5 or higher) comes and goes over any period of time
- Cough continues to interrupt sleep and ability to participate in activities
- Congestion requires frequent wiping of nose/ mouth due to runny nose or excessive saliva
- Fatigue makes it difficult for your child to participate
- Your child had diarrhea or vomited within the last 24 hours
